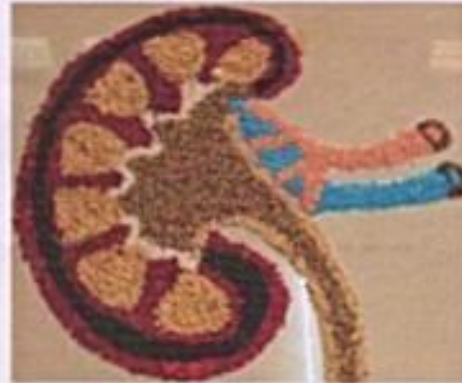


### Advantages :

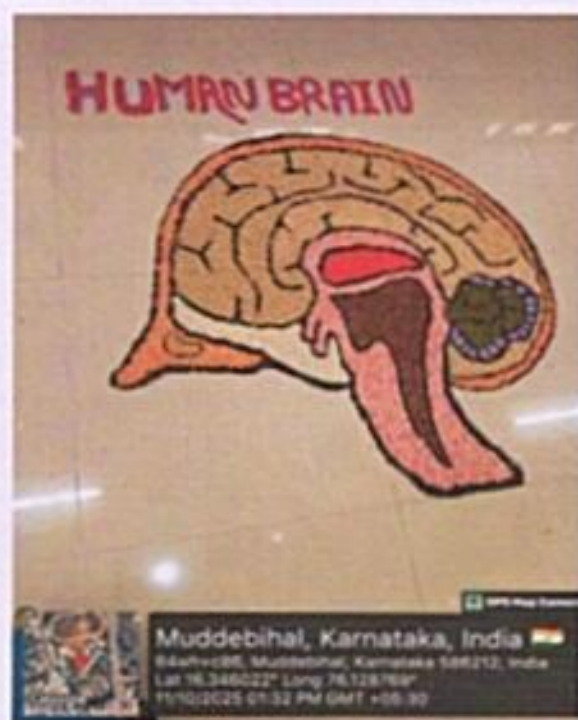

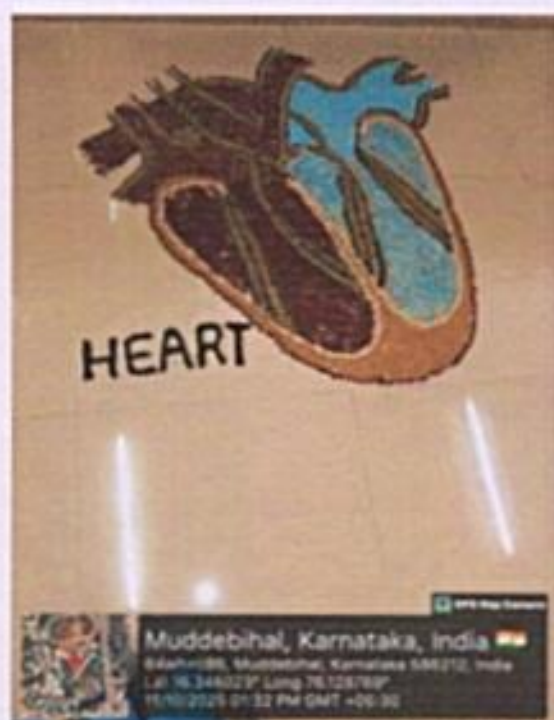

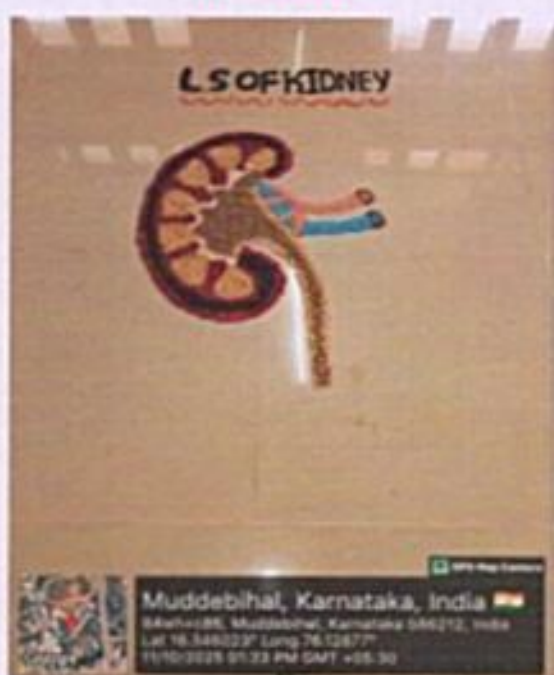


