More recently, the term has come to be understood to further include *any* written, typed, or word-processed copy of an author's work, as distinguished from its rendition as a printed version of the same.^[2] Before the arrival of printing, all documents and books were manuscripts. Manuscripts are not defined by their contents, which may combine writing with mathematical calculations, maps, music notation, explanatory figures or illustrations.

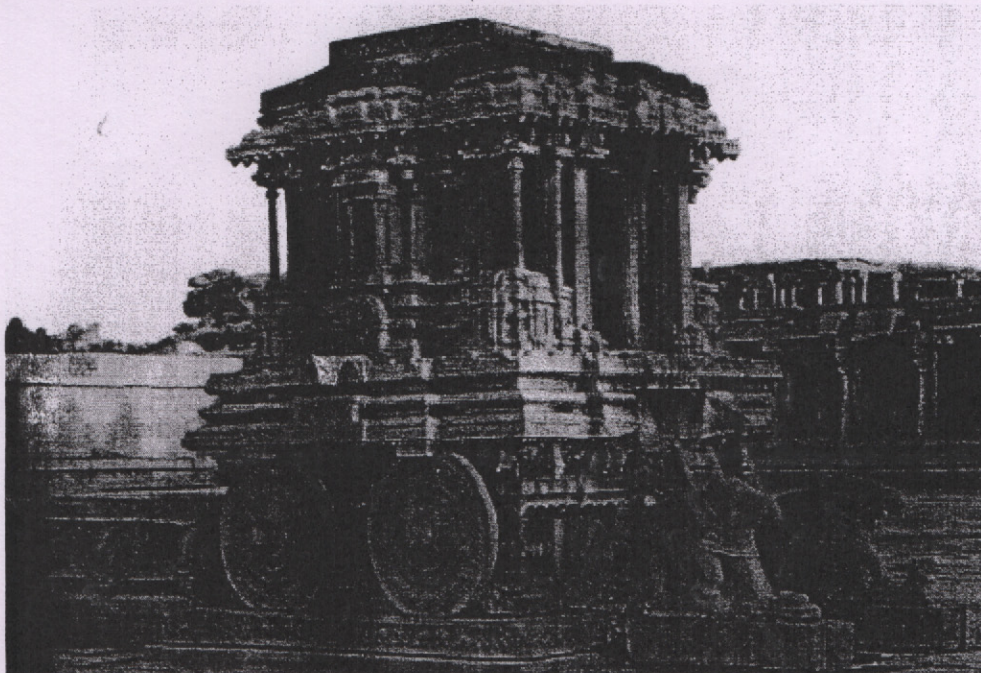

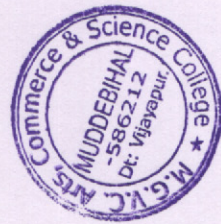

5. Conclusion

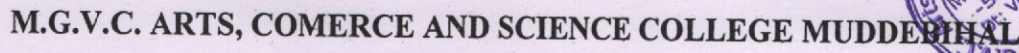
