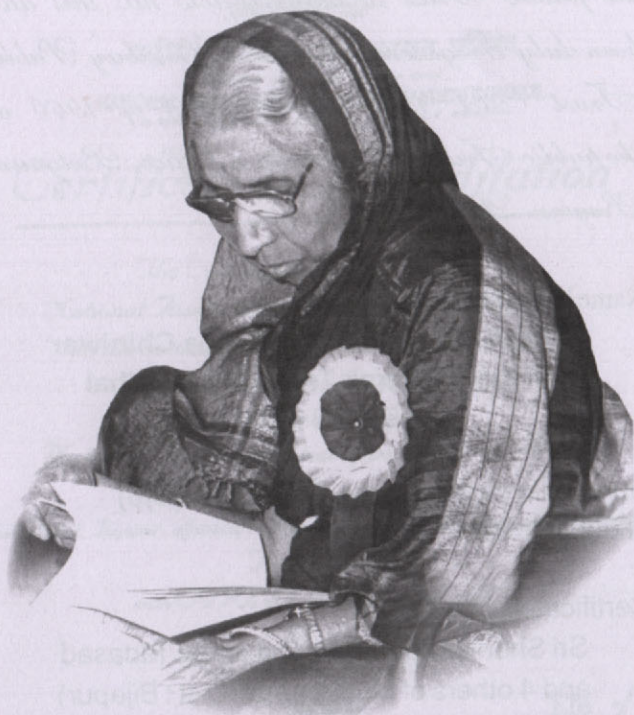

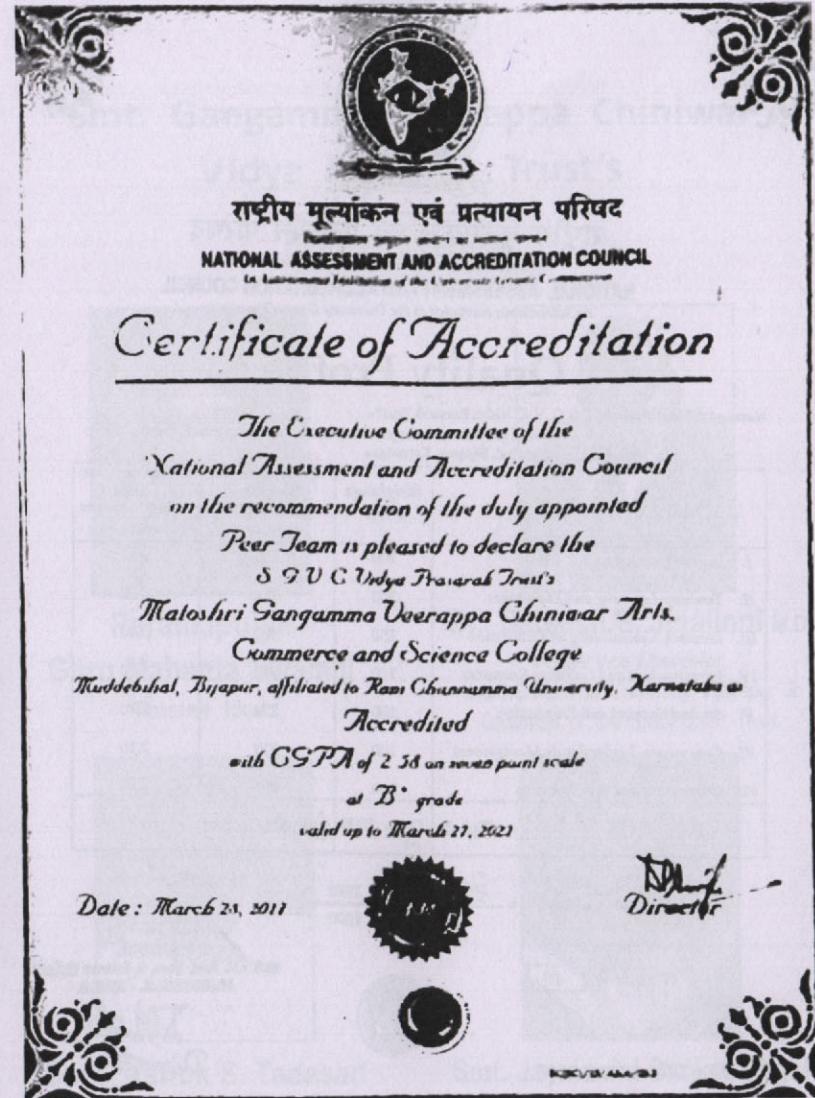

## General Rules

Students who wish to get admission in our College must follow the rules of institution.

- 1) All columns shall be filled in the prescribed application form.
- 2) Two Xerox copies of Marks Card should be enclosed.
- 3) Two recent photo copies should be attached along with the application form.
- 4) Transfer certificate from previously learned institution.
- 5) Enclose copies of Income and Caste certificate in three sets.
- 6) In case of transfer from another college to our College, Admission will be allowed by the previous College Principal with recommendation letter of RCU and admission will be provided if there is vacancy in our college.
- 7) Other University students to enroll in our college should bring the eligibility certificate of RCU Belagavi.
- 8) All rules and regulations of our college must be followed.
- 9) Newly enrolled students must keep a caution deposit. Students who leave college in middle of the academic year will not return the caution deposit.
- 10) Identity Card is Mandatory to all students.
- 11) Students Representatives will be nominated on the basis of marks obtained in the previous annual examination in the respective class.
- 12) Students should have 75% attendance compulsory for annual examination.

## Library

The college is proud of the rich collection of books, journals and periodicals in its library. In all there are 34,959 books worth of Rs. 19.50 lakhs and also there are 10,775 books worth Rs. 11 lakhs from UGC grants. It supplements the learning process of the students and teachers. 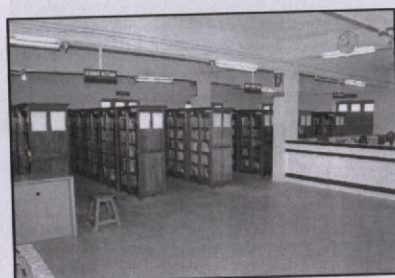

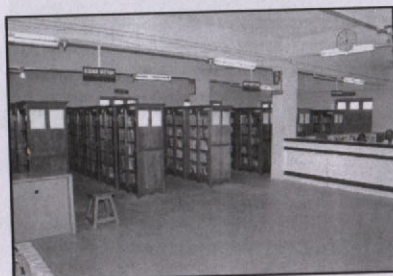

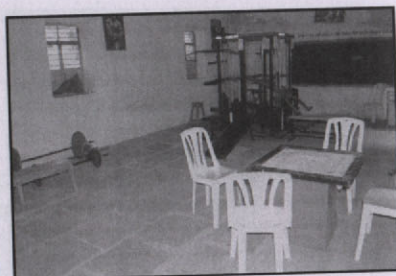

- Commensurate with the gravity of the offence, the punishment includes fine, expulsion from the hostel/ college and handing over the case to the law enforcing authorities of the Government.



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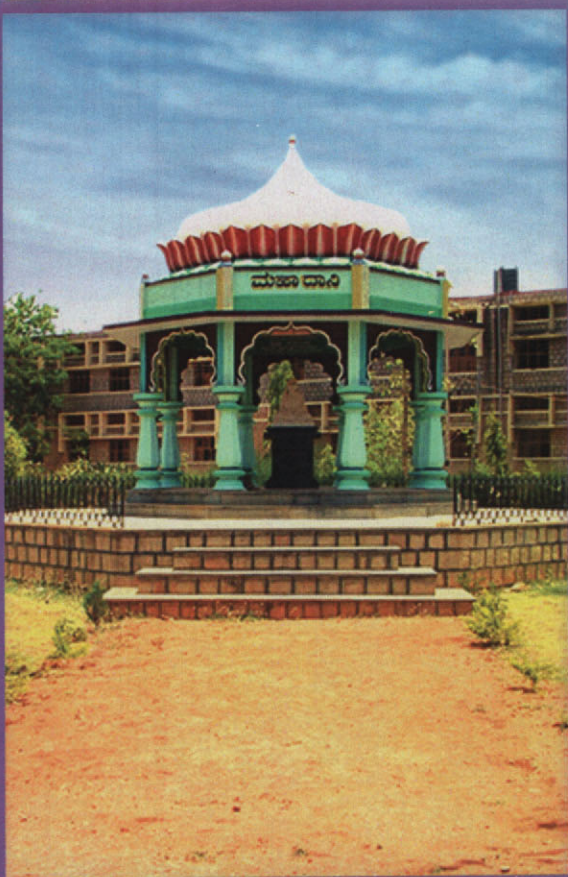
